- Tutoring after school. Targeted subjects: Alg 1, Geometry, Biology, US History and ELA
- Spring Break camp is being planned: ELA 9/10, Algebra, Biology
- Tuesday calls to students who have a D or F. Information is pulled from Skyward. Calls are sent in 4 languages: English, Spanish, Haitian Creole and Portugese. Good response.
- Parents are struggling with Skyward and the set-up. Skyward Help Virtual Training 2/9/21 via Teams.
- Cap and Gown pick up April 2021
- Senior Week being planned by SGA
- Lots of Testing. PMAs 2/24. SAT School Day 3/3 for Juniors.
- Athletics Spring Sports is going on. Winter Sports is winding down. OHS is hosting District Basketball and the Men's Team is doing well.
- SEL Social and Emotional Learning. This is a school district initiative. There's a lot focused on adults on campus. Adults have to focus on their own wellness. OHS got a huge shout out for the Wellness Room. THANK YOU PTSA.

- COVID update. There was a little spike last week. Extra cleaning machines were purchased at the beginning of the year. Machines are used daily.
- ~1400 Face2Face students on campus. More tables were purchased for outside.
- Parent/Family Survey. Please help. We need 20% of parents and family to complete. 20% of 3,000=600 surveys. Only 50 surveys have been submitted.
- When will State allow vaccines for teachers? Don't know
- Has threshold changed for schools to pivot? Based on ability to run school/function.
 Quarantine time has changed from 14 days to 10 days.

 - \$180. Shipping: Free
 - Popcorn Maker to use popcorn as reading incentive
 - All students would be impacted
 - PTSA handled the grant request
- 2. AP Science Teachers Zachary Morgan, Hilary Roath, John Zielinsky, Tiffany Lohman
 - \$1762.50. Shipping: n/a
 - Subscription to Pivot Interactives (Virtual Labs for AP Sciences)
 - 375 students would be impacted
 - Subscription would benefit the LaunchEd students, or when F2F is not an option
 - Longevity: 1 year
 - Grant was tabled. Ms. Gorberg will speak with Mr. Morgan and AP science teachers.
 - Motion presented by Myles Bradford that if Ms. Gorberg is unable to cover, SAC would cover a pro-rated amount up to \$881 (1/2 of the subscription amount).
