## ELECTIVES - 24 Required Credits

Most college-level credit courses taught at Valencia will count toward elective credit. Any credits in excess of the minimum required in any of the five course areas listed will count as elective credits. University majors required certain prerequisite courses before transferring. These courses should be taken as electives at Valencia.

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## Foreign Language Proficiency

Valencia's college-level foreign language proficiency requirement can be satisfied in one of the following ways:
**You may complete two credits (two years) of high school instruction in one language other than English with a passing grade each year as documented on your official high school transcript.
**You may satisfy this requirement by successfully completing foreign language course work at the Elementary II college level with a minimum grade of "C."
**You may satisfy this requirement by passing an Advanced Placement Foreign Language exam of 4 or higher.
**You may satisfy this requirement by passing a CLEP (College Level Examination Program) foreign language test or a foreign language proficiency test administered by the University of Central Florida. Students who earn college-level foreign language credits through course work or CLEP may apply these credits toward the 24 Elective credits.
**If your native language is a language other than English, you may satisfy the foreign language proficiency requirement by successful completion of English for Academic Purposes (EAP).
