

- OCPS Advanced Placement students took over 37,000 AP exams in May 2017
- By scoring a 3, 4, or 5 on an AP exam, OCPS AP students can earn college
 credit at colleges and universities within the Florida State University System
- OCPS AP students saved over 9.5 million dollars in college tuition as a result of the May 2017 AP exam administration
